

The National Cancer Strategy 2006-2009 is a document of 34 pages with different objectives and proposed actions. The basis for the document are recommendations from the report on “National Strategy for work in cancer care – quality, expertise and capacity” (2004) and a national consultation in autumn of 2004. The strategy focuses on:

- Prevention
- National Screening programs
- The meeting between the cancer patient, health care and community
- Diagnostics
- Treatment
- Alternative treatment
- Rehabilitation
- Relieving treatment
- Personnel capacity and competence
- Cancer Registry, national medical quality registers and research

The strategy was extended from 2009 to 2011.
